# Recent History

- Increased graduation rates from 75.1% in 2018-19 to 84.9% in the 2019-20 school year
- Increase in the percentage of students who are English Learners from 11% to 21% over last 6 years
- Tenure of Dr. Alex Apostle to provide 6-years of continuity of district leadership
- Designation of the Shelton School Board as a school board of distinction by the Washington State School Directors Association for the past four years.
- Launch of Health Science Academy in 2018 followed by three more academies: Natural Resources, Business/Finance/Hospitality, and Mechanical Engineering/Technology
- Opening of Cedar High School in fall of 2020 and now housed at Olympic College – Shelton Campus
- Passage of the \$65 million dollar bond in 2017, positively impacting and improving all facilities in the Shelton School District
- Award of \$19 million in state match funds from the bond passage, leading to updating of athletic complexes and construction of a new gymnasium at Bordeaux Elementary School.
- Awarded participation in a federally funded grant to build Positive Behavior Intervention Supports



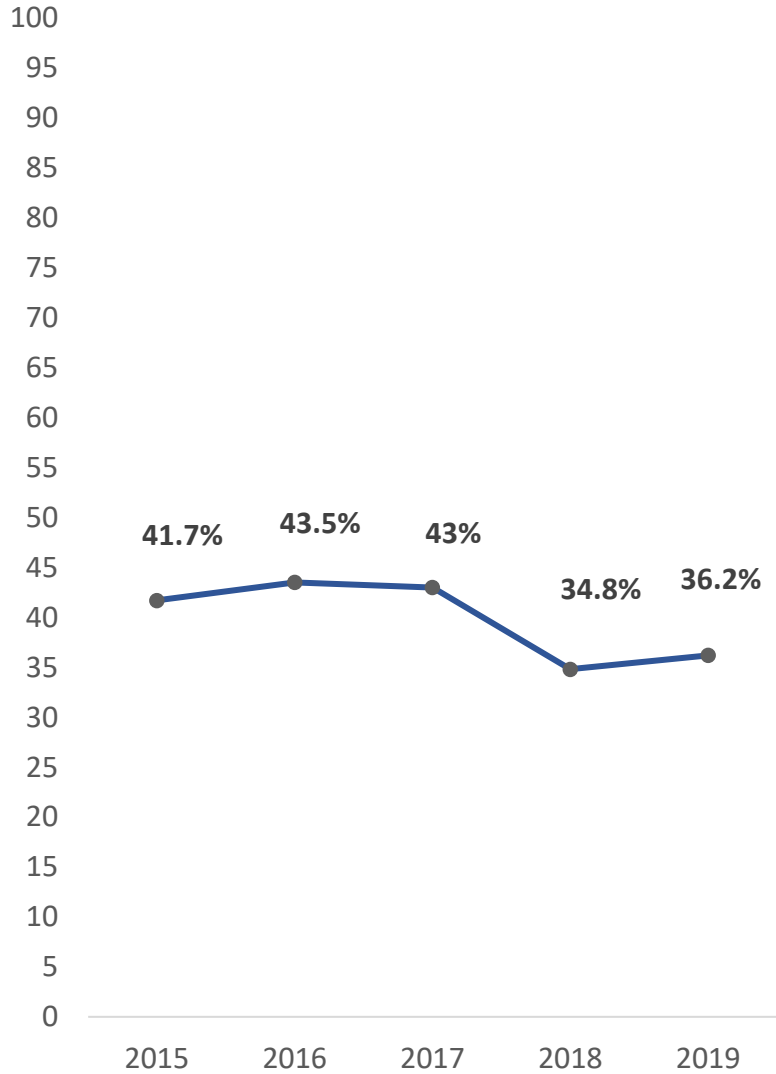

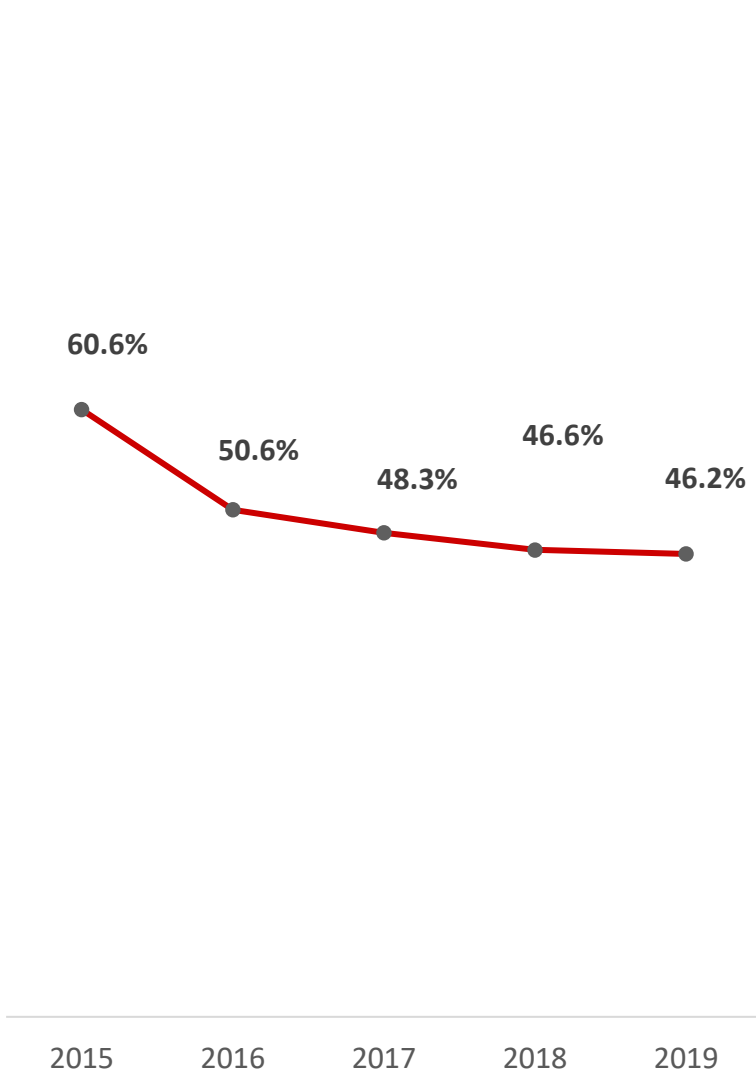


# ELA Proficiency Trends: All Students

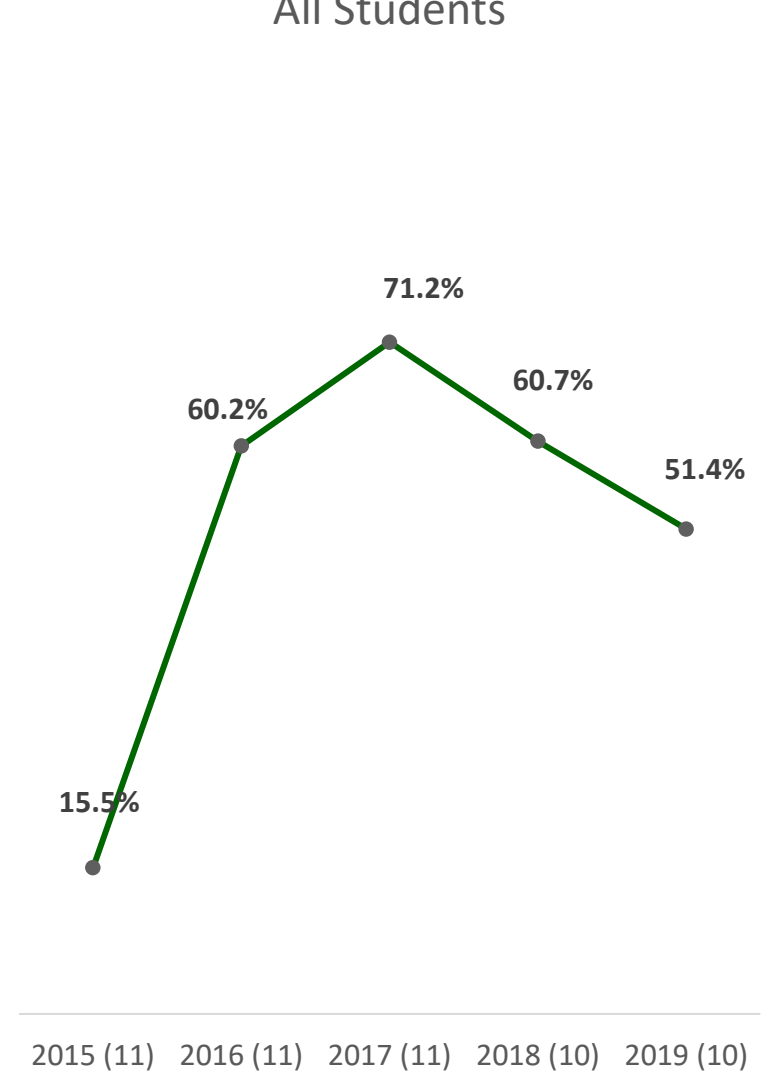
## 3rd Grade Trend For All Students



## 7th Grade Trend for All Students

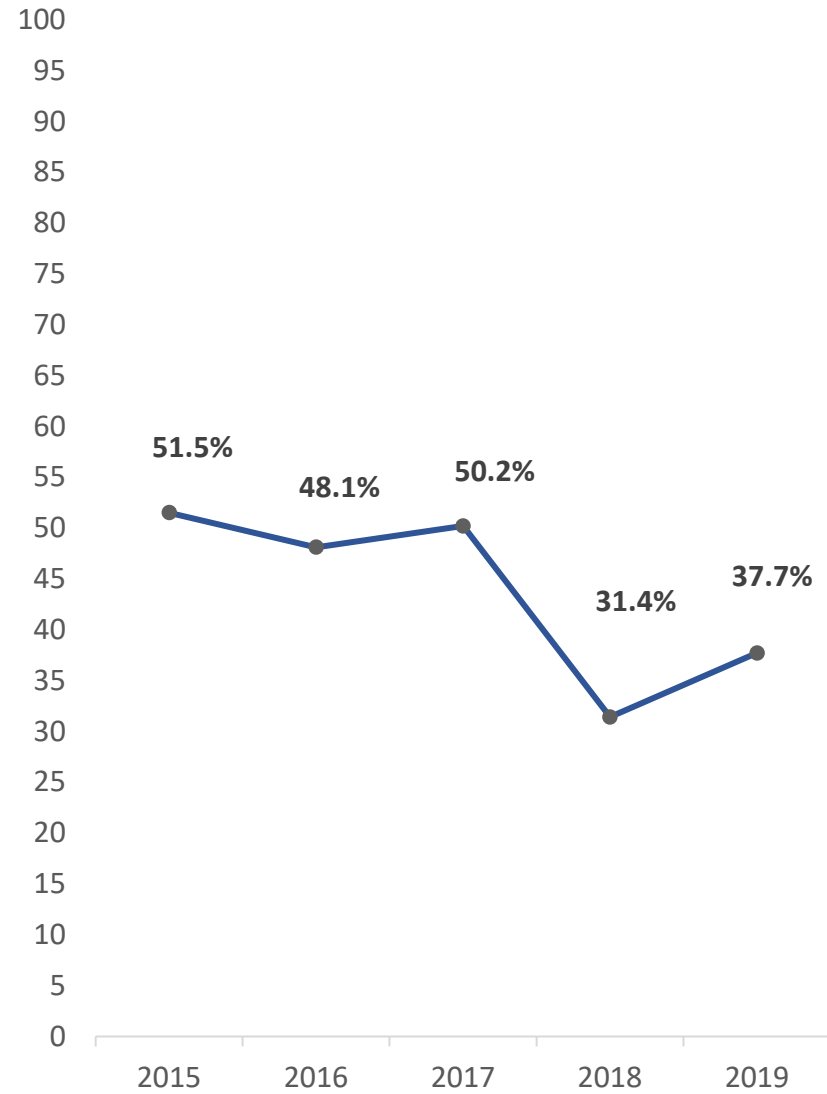


## High School (10/11) Trend for All Students

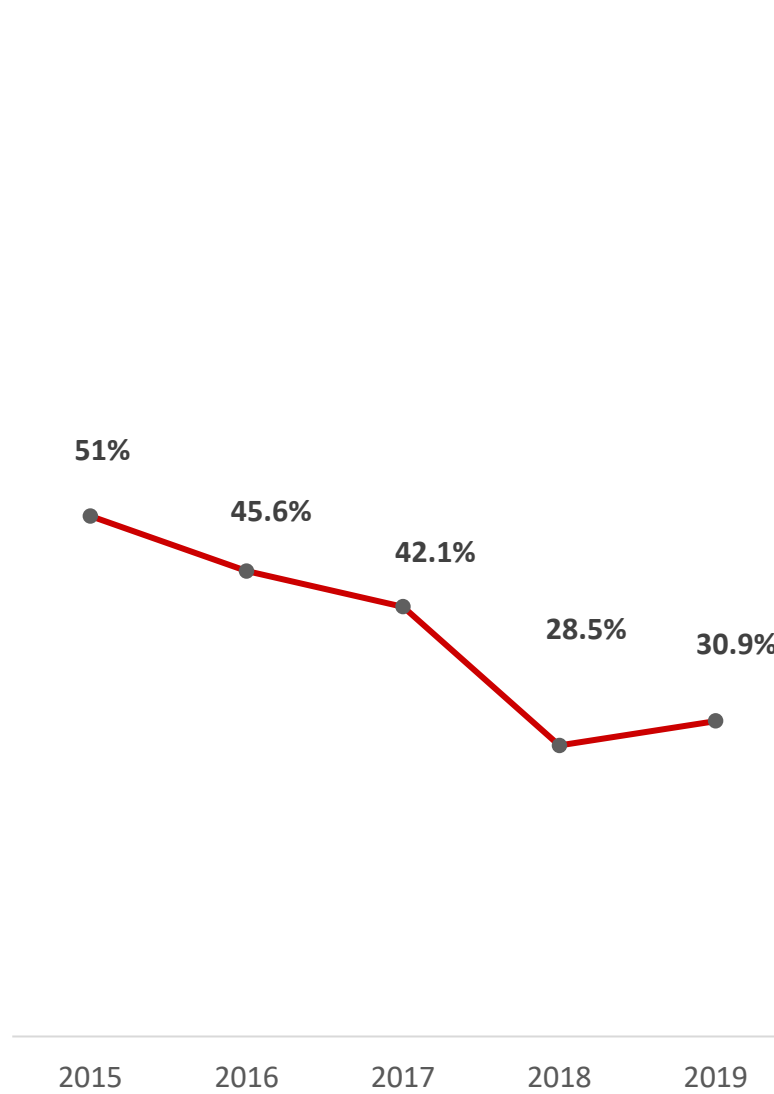

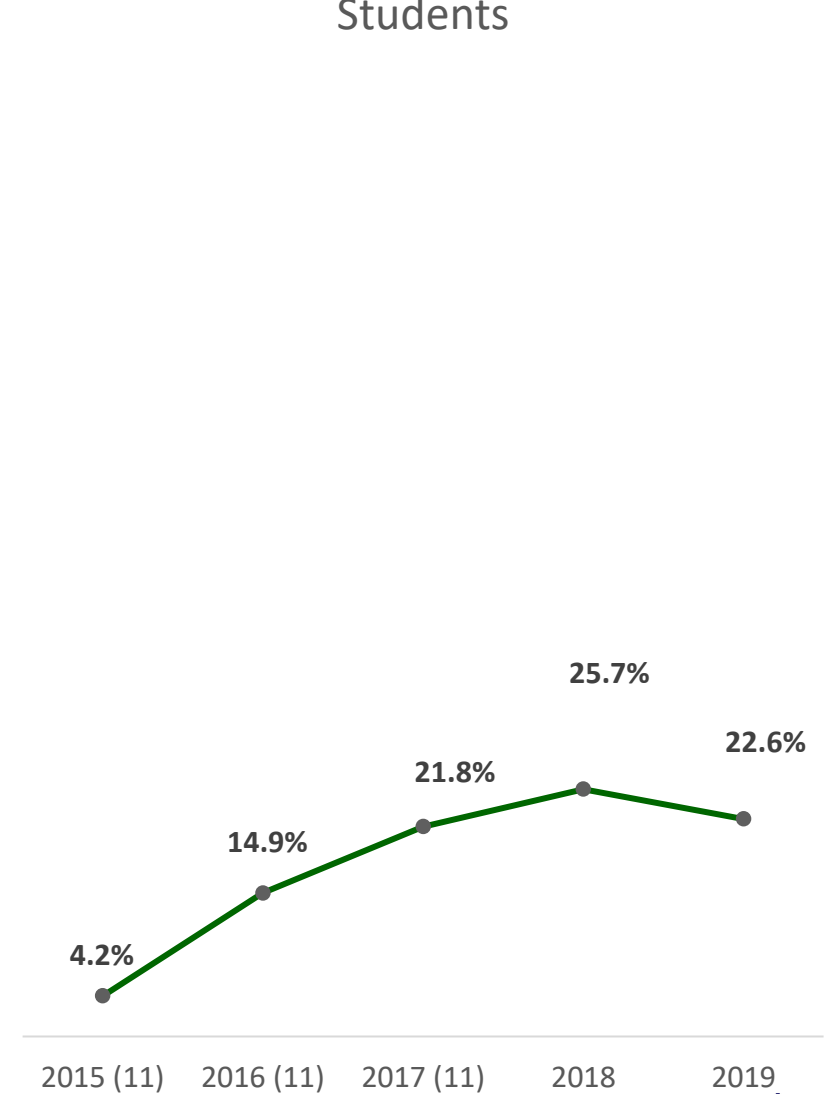

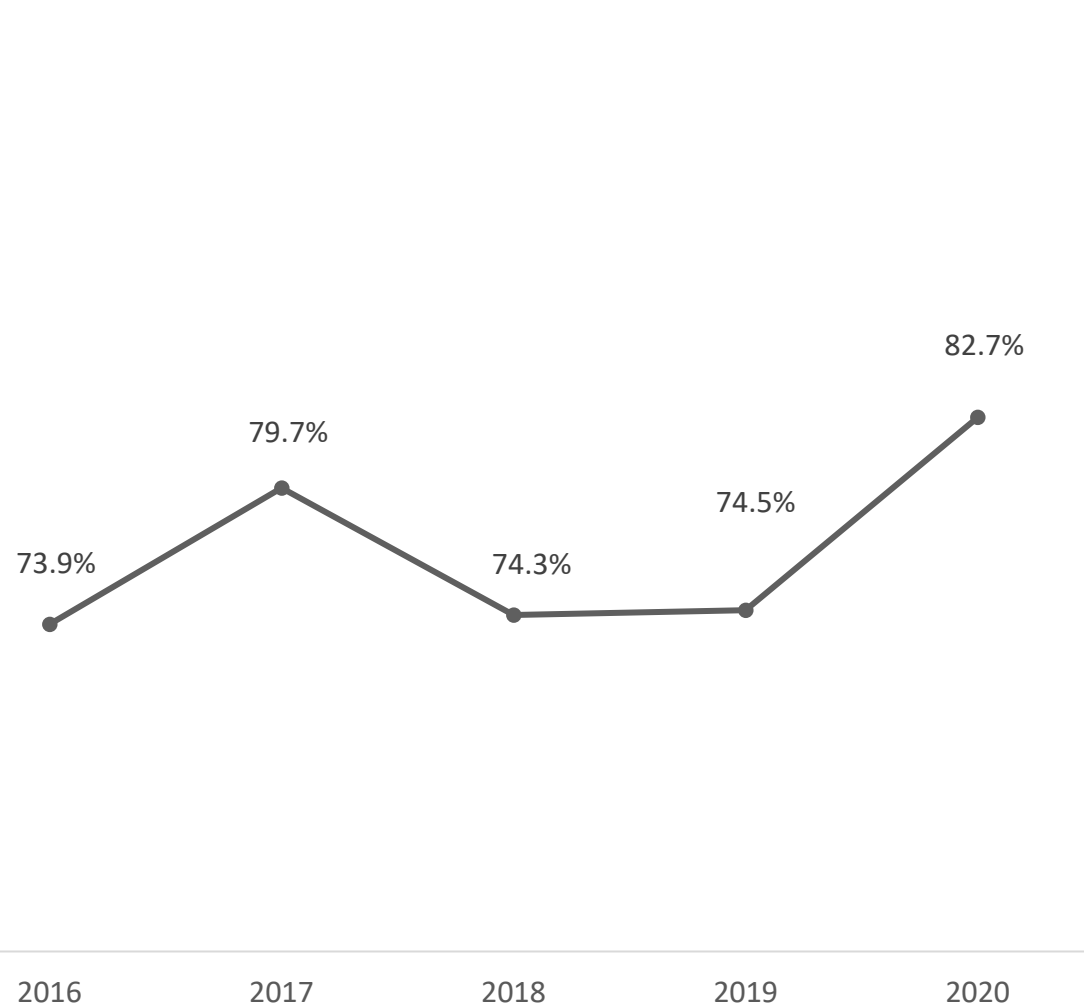

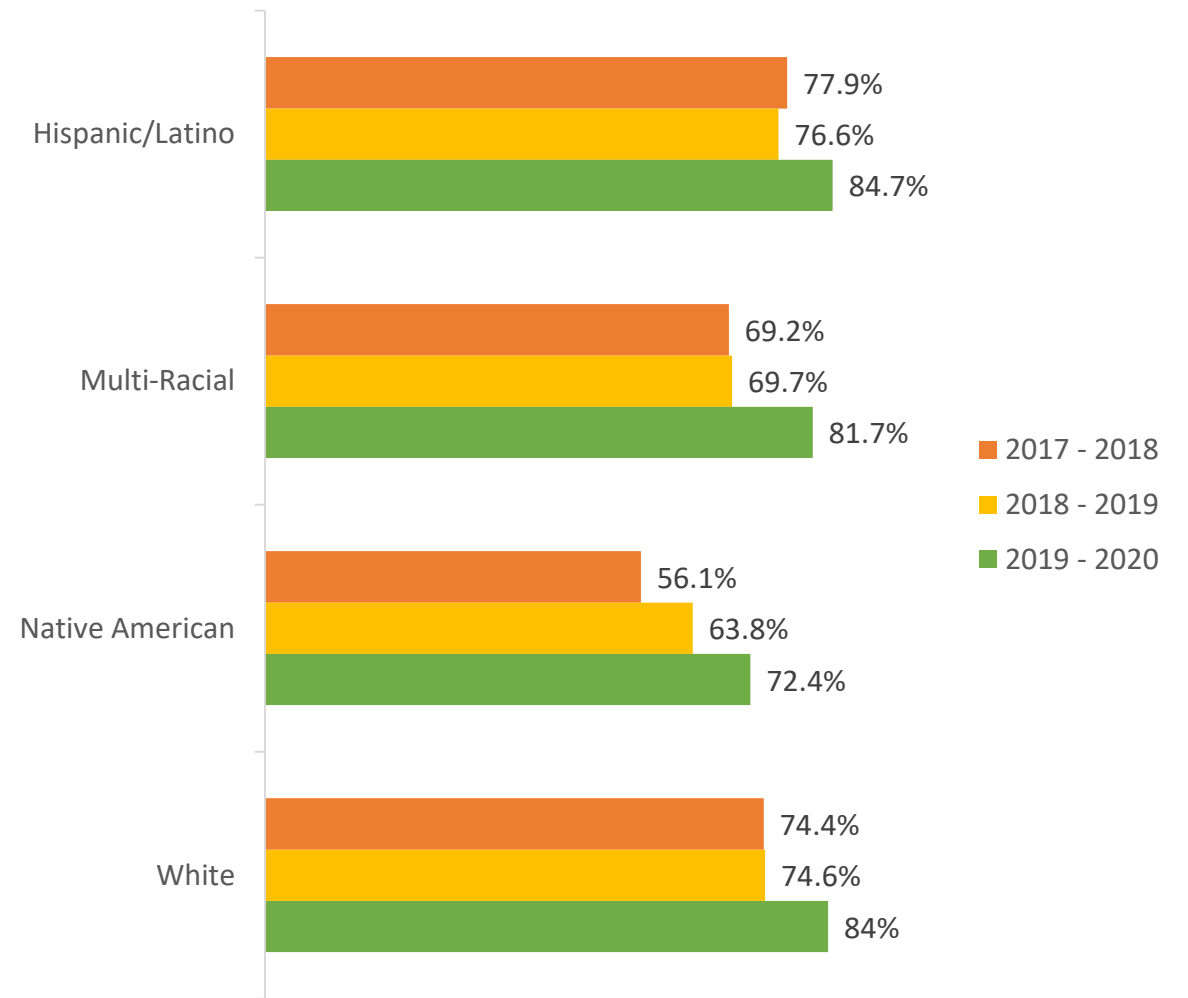

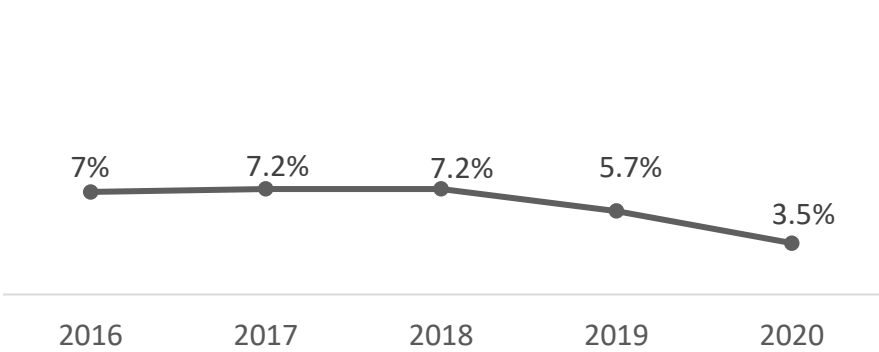
### Trend by Race/Ethnicity



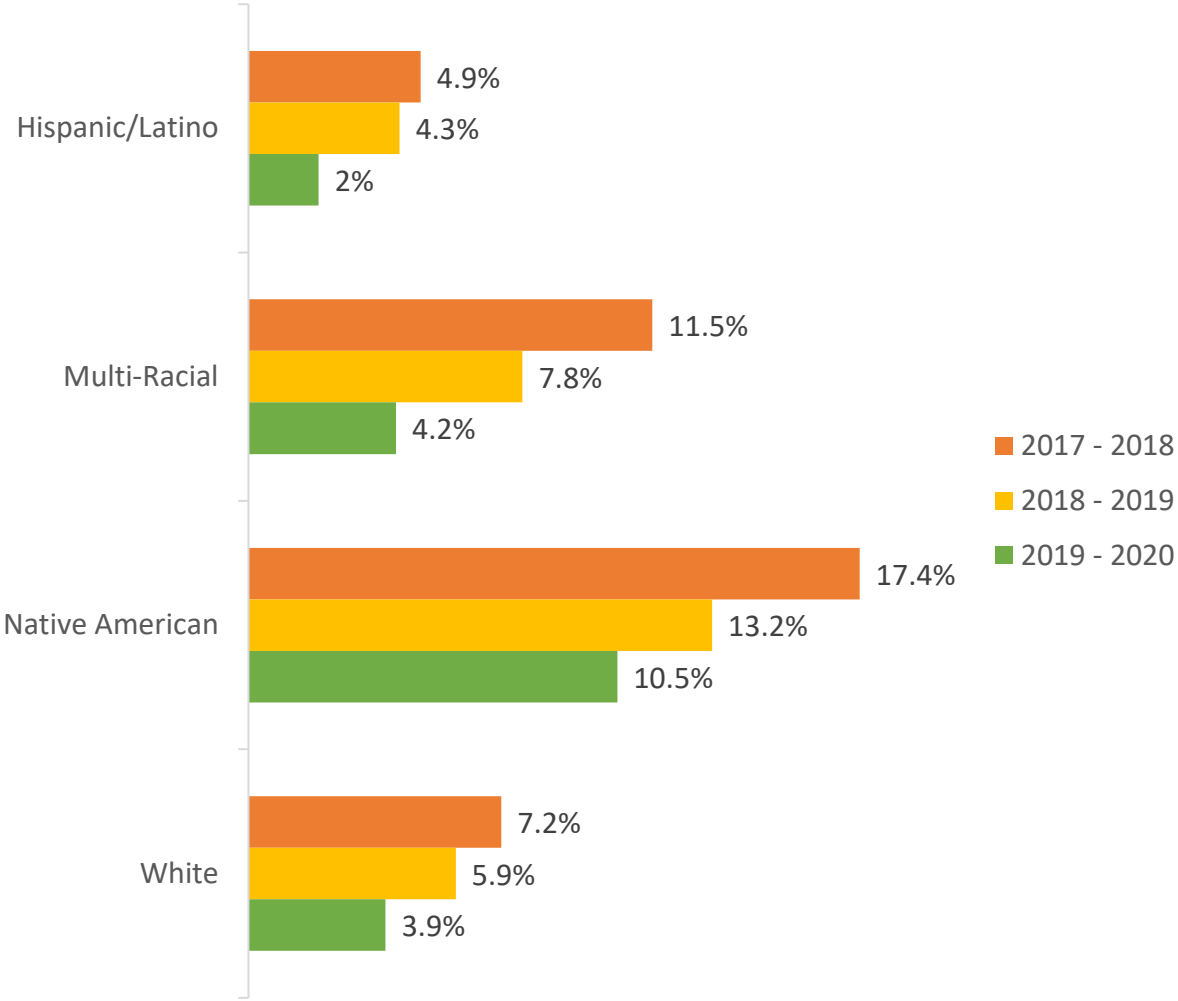

## Percentage of Students Excluded on the Basis of a Behavioral Violation

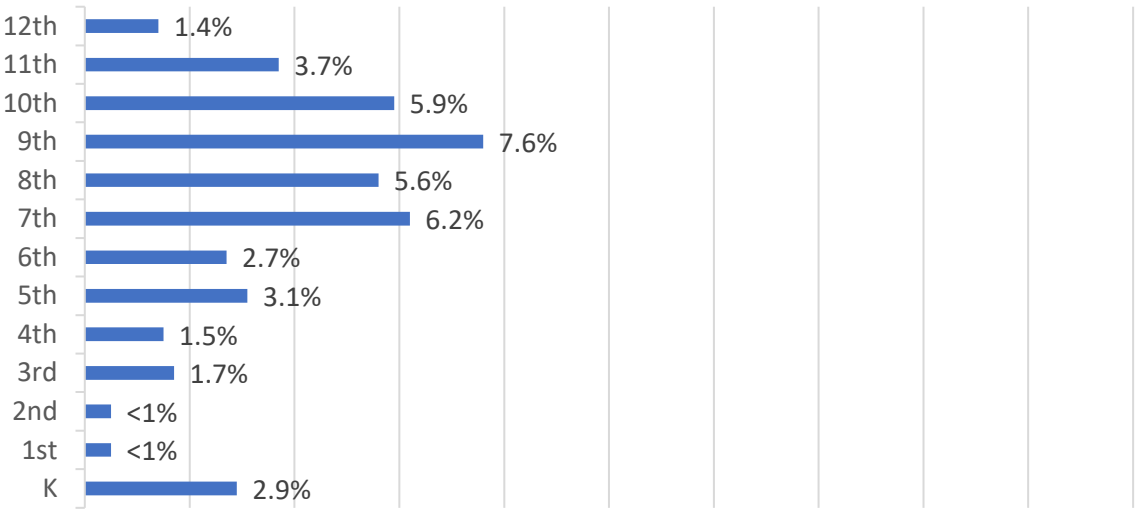

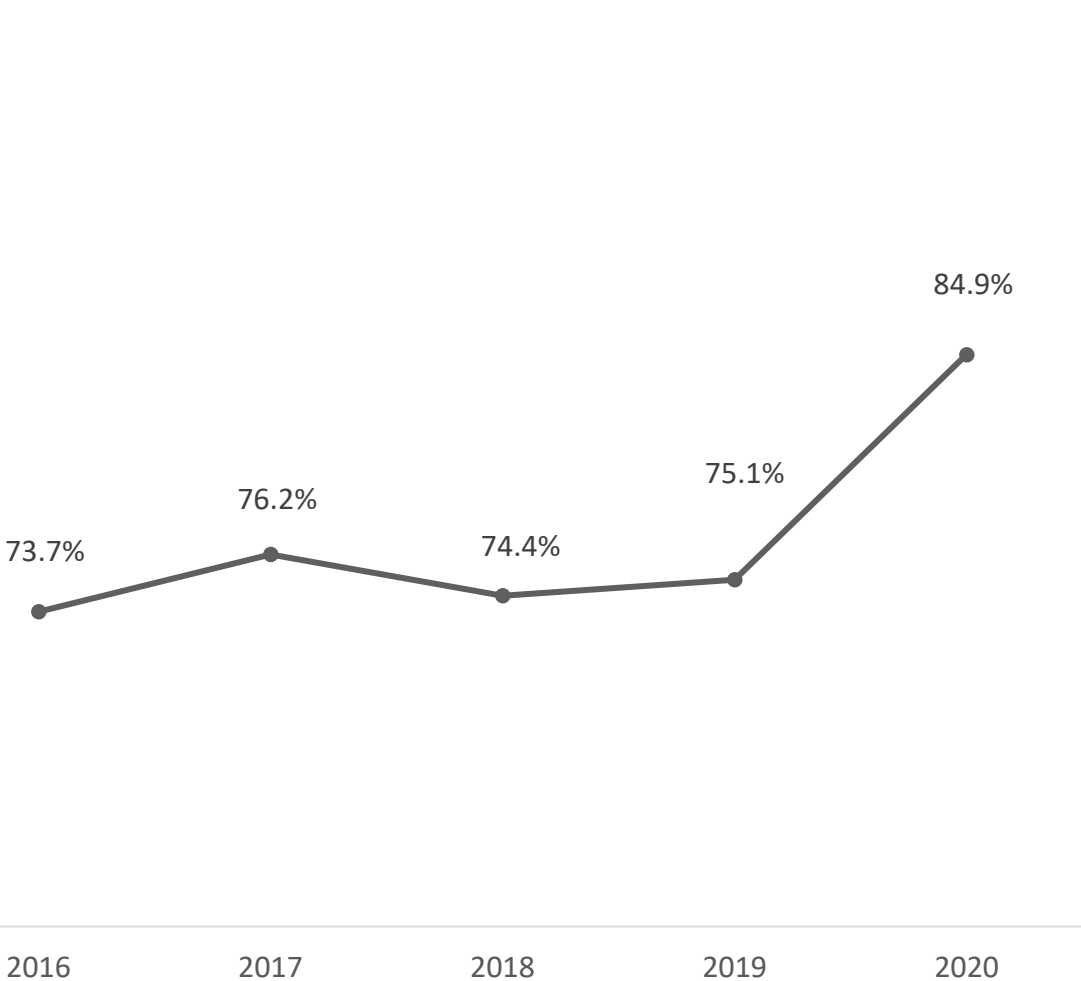
2019 – 2020 Discipline by Grade Level



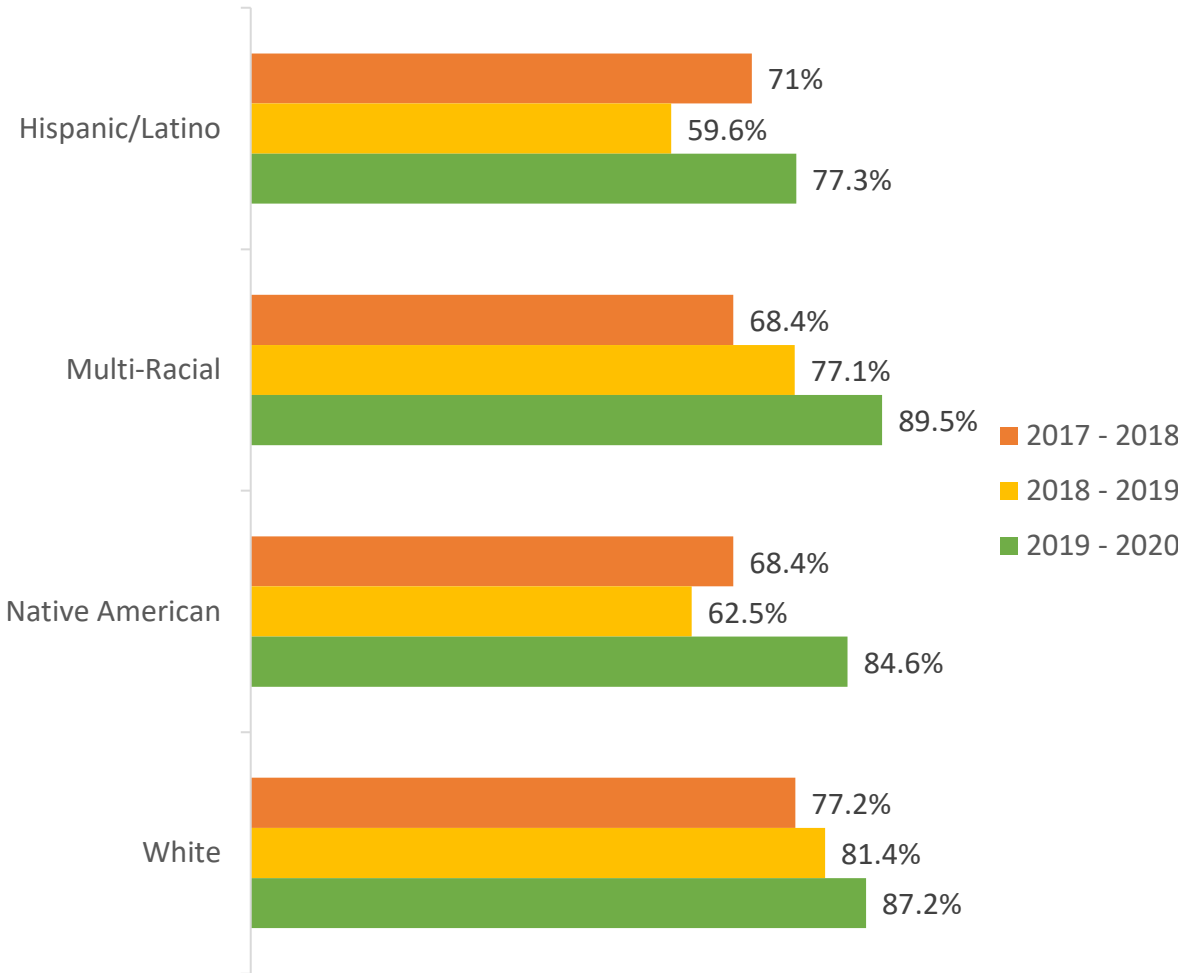

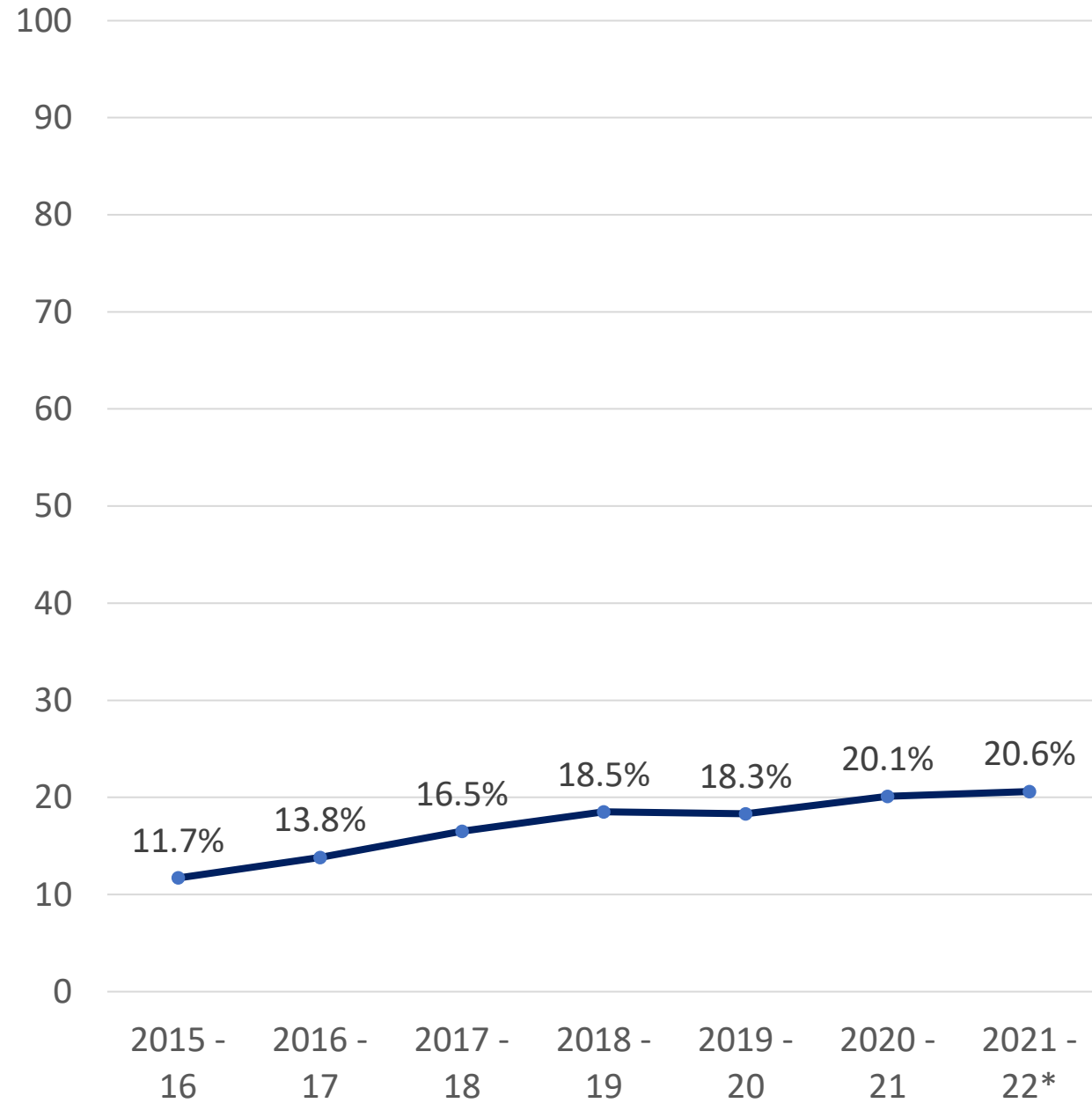


# Current Demographic and Programmatic Enrollment Trends for Key Indicator Grades

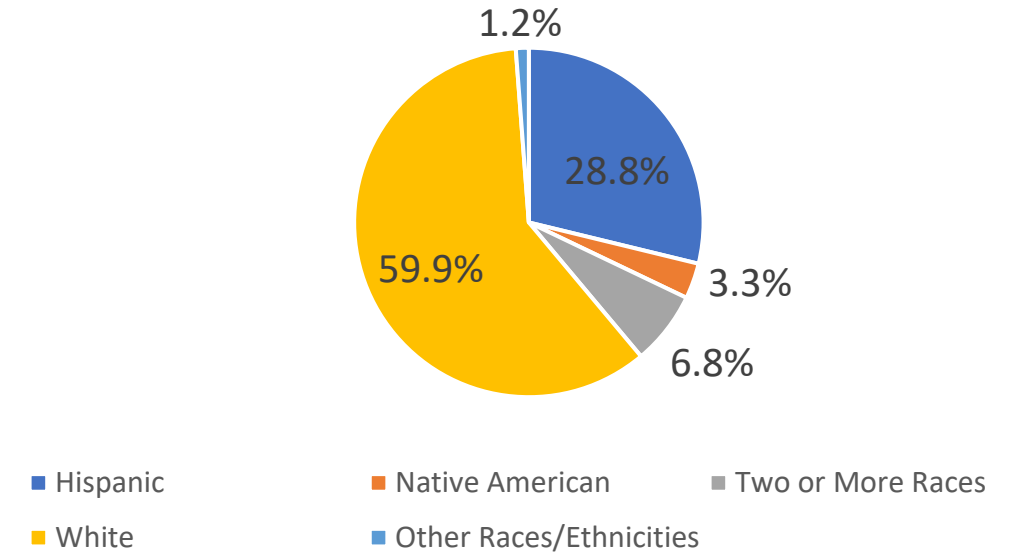

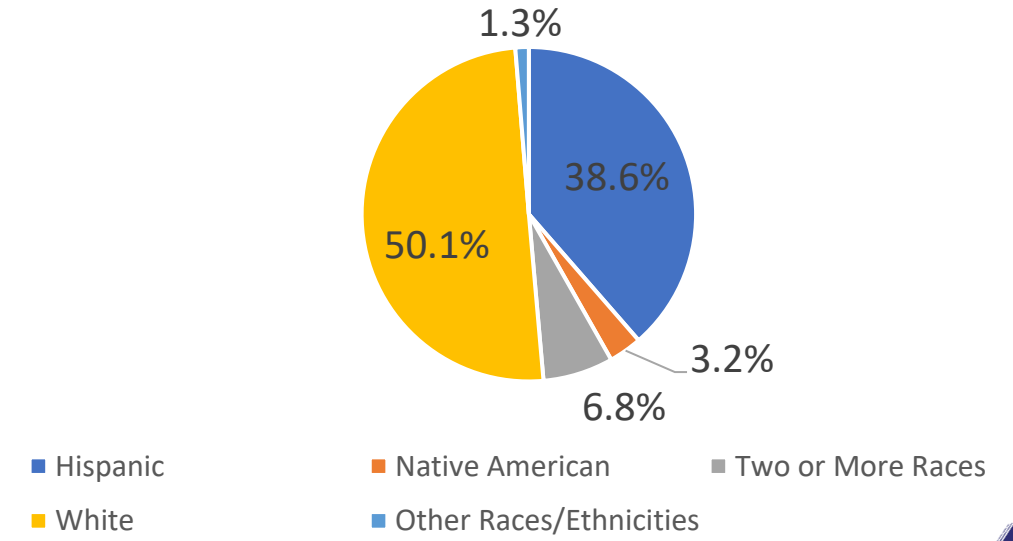
## 2015 – 2022 English Language Learner Enrollment Trends, District-Wide

## 2021 - 2022 Enrollment by Demographics

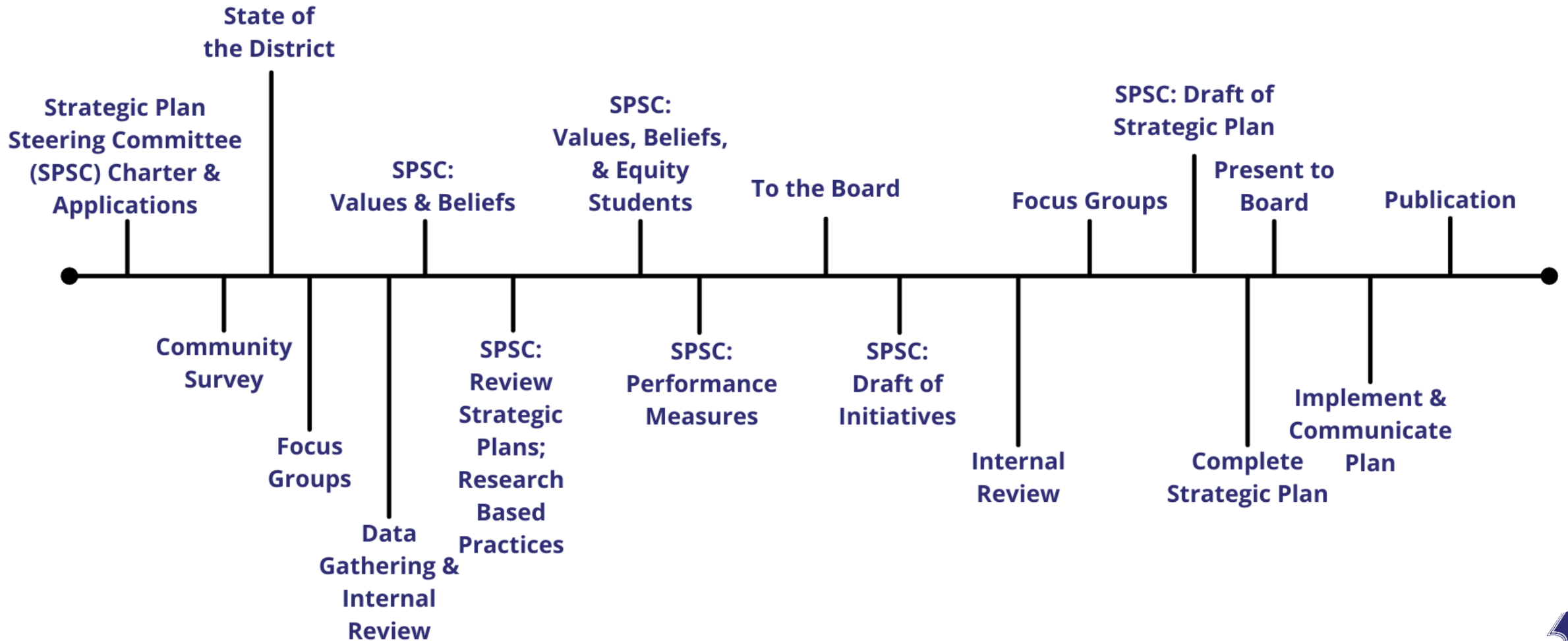
