

Highclimber Academy

The Highclimber Academy (HCA) ensures a smooth transition for incoming high school students and offers opportunities to explore various career content areas before choosing an academy and pathway to study.



Business, Finance, & Hospitality

Business, Finance, and Hospitality Academy (BFH): BFH explores business, finance, marketing, culinary arts, hospitality, entertainment and multimedia, providing a wide range of skills for various career endeavors.



Health Sciences

Health Science Academy (HSA): HSA offers pathways that explore healthcare, patient care, nutrition, fitness, and medical research, preparing students for careers in the medical field.





Manufacturing, Engineering, & Technology

Manufacturing, Engineering, and Technology Academy (MET): Preparing students with skills in construction, automotive, welding, electronics, engineering, and related disciplines, to ensure readiness for careers in technology and manufacturing.



Natural Resources

Students will have opportunities to participate in mock interview questions and experience real-life scenarios, prompts, and techniques used in interviews, with feedback for improvement.



Q&A Sessions

Guest speakers, panelists, and vendors will host Q&A Sessions following each breakout session for students to learn more from various industry professionals about their work and experience.

Academies and Pathways

Students can see their Academy and Pathway using Skyward. Students will be assigned to **breakout sessions by Academy.** Freshman will be assigned by their YouScience results.

College and Career Interests

Review your results on YouScience to explore various career pathways that align with your aptitudes, interests, and skills.

Resumes & Cover Letters

Bring several copies of your resume and cover letters, if you have specific employers, schools, or industry partners that you hope to connect with.

Professionalism & Behavior

Dress appropriately for the training and career pathway you intend to be on, and always behave with professionalism when interacting with other students, staff, and guests on campus (speakers, vendors, industry partners, and community members)
