Company History

- Founded in 1890 as Simpson Logging Company by Sol Simpson
- First sawmill opened in 1925
 - Diversified into plywood, pulp mills, and more
 - Continued to own and manage timberlands as Simpson Timber Company
- In 2004, the company split operations and timberlands (Simpson and Green Diamond Resource Company)
- Created subsidiary known as Green Diamond Management Company in 2018



- Conformance verified annually through extensive third-party audits

 - Biodiversity and Wildlife Habitat
 - Forest Productivity and Wildfire
 - Certification standards promote forest-focused collaborations with neighboring Tribes and local communities
- **Conservation and Education**
Research and Resources linked by Standards
 - Increase the scale of conservation efforts







Habitat Conservation Plan (HCP) & Forest Practices

- Habitat Conservation Plan (HCP) – 2000
 - The rules we use for timber harvesting and land management
 - Agreement with USFWS and NOAA Fisheries
 - Tailored to our land
 - Covers: 51 species
 - 30 aquatic species
 - 21 terrestrial or bird species
- Washington Forest Practices Act – 1974
- Washington Forests and Fish Law – 1999
 - Rules protect public safety and resources
 - Standards for logging, roads, pesticides
 - Maintains viable forest products industry in the state
